Please feel free to email in advance any vital issue including absences, tardies, behavior, conferences or related issues. Please do not expect to discuss major issues via walk-ins.

<u>Arrival</u>

Students will come to class from the main entrance. We will adhere to all new arrival and dismissal procedures for this school year.

Absences/Family Trips

When your child is absent for any reason, please remember to send a written note the following day when he/she returns to school. Please include name and date. If a note is not received, the absence is marked as unexcused. If your child will be absent for trip related reasons, you must notify the administrator at least five days in advance for approval.

Severe Weather / School Closing

Mr. Dawson will need a primary cell phone number from each parent. You will be notified via text message in the case of severe weather or school closing. Please be mindful that text updates may be sent from an unidentified number. Please reply to the text immediately to ensure that you and your family are safe and have received the update.

Homework/Testing

Weekly test guides and Bible verses will be printed and placed in the front pocket of student folders each week. The test guide will assist each student in being prepared for testing. Homework will not be assigned on Wednesday. However, incomplete or make-up work may be assigned. Homework assignments usually consist of Math and Phonics worksheets, Reading assignments as well as other assigned tasks.

Lunch

All school lunches must be pre-ordered. If a student does not bring a lunch, he/she will be sent to the office to call home. For personal lunches, please be mindful of sending items that are easy to open and consume. Please note microwaves have been removed from the cafeteria.

Snacks & Eagle Bucks Cards

Students may bring personal snack items to consume during snack break. Snack items should be smaller items to be consumed in a timely manner. Parents may send individually wrapped snack items for the class as desired. Students may purchase Eagle Bucks cards in the main office. Eagle Bucks cards can be used during lunch period to purchase ice cream, drinks or additional items.

Birthday Treats & Surprises

Birthdays will be celebrated during lunch break in the cafeteria. You may send birthday treats. Please inform Mr. Dawson of all plans and arrangements in advance.

Behavior / Discipline

Conduct grades will be given on a weekly basis. The conduct grade will be included when calculating the student's overall grade point average.

Classroom Rules

- 1. Be prepared.
- 2. Follow directions.
- 3. Raise your hand for permission to speak.
- 4. Stay on task.
- 5. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.
- 6. Treat others and property with respect.

<u>Discipline consequences</u>: behavior will be documented via check mark system. All students will be given an initial verbal warning.

<u>1st check</u> – 3 points deducted from weekly grade

2nd check – 6 points deducted from weekly grade

 3^{rd} check – 9 points deducted and minutes deducted

from recess

4th check – 12 points deducted and minutes deducted from recess

 5^{th} check – 15 points deducted and minutes deducted from recess

Severe action: 20 points deducted, extra assignments or parent notified.

All Behavior notices will be placed in Headmaster for documentation.

Reasons for check marks:

- *Not following directions first time asked
- *Consistently off task
- *Disrupting class
- *Out of seat too often
- *Playing in cafeteria, hallway lines or special classes
- *Excessive talking or playing
- *Unkind or disrespectful to teacher and others
- *Incomplete homework
- *Papers not returned as requested
- *Failure to keep hands, feet and other objects to vourself
- *Academic Dishonesty, hitting or excessive force

Daily Procedures

Students should come to class prepared to learn.

On arrival, students should enter the classroom quietly and place homework, notes from parents and other information in appropriate trays. Students should place book bags on the back of his/her chair and lunch boxes in the designated area. Students should then complete the morning assignment or read or draw quietly until class begins.

Hallway Lines

Students should line up quietly. Students are expected to stand behind the person in front of them, a few feet apart and away from the wall. Students should face forward and there should be no talking. The students should keep hands and feet to themselves and should not touch the walls or another student.

Classroom Manners

All students are expected to help with classroom duties. (*Pass papers, clean work area, lead pledge, prayer, etc.*)

Students are also expected to stay on task, be kind by speaking to others kindly, willing to help others, work in assigned groups, play and treat others fairly and use appropriate manners. ("Yes, No, Good Morning, Goodbye, May I have, May I use, May I go to the restroom.")
